Big Yellow recommended low volume irrigation throughout the community and will provide a proposal for the May 23, 2012 Board Meeting to provide low drip irrigation and timers for the areas that still need low volume irrigation. Dan Chiarito will provide the paperwork necessary to request a watering variance with the city of Tampa.

Big Yellow will continue the landscaping installation currently in progress as plants are ordered and will only last a few weeks more in their pots. Mulch will also be installed.

Representatives from Big Yellow will attend the May 23, 2012 Board meeting to discuss the proposals and discuss aerating the soil, fertilization, and the cost of water trucks.
